GRANT GIVING POLICY

UK GRANTS

For families living in the UK we give grants as follows:

GRANT TYPE	AMOUNT	CONDITIONS
Bereavement	£300	Copy of death certificate stating ALD as cause of death or similar. Payable to family.
Bone Marrow Transplant	£300	Copy of letter stating patient requires bmt due to ALD. Payable to parents/guardians.
Equipment	variable	Invoice/estimate for goods plus letter from medical professional stating necessity and that item is not available on NHS. Payable direct to provider.
Treatment	variable	Invoice/estimate for treatment plus letter from medical professional stating necessity and that treatment is not available on NHS. Payable direct to provider.
Care	variable	Invoice/estimate for care needs plus letter from medical professional/ social worker stating necessity and that care is not available through social services. Payable direct to provider.
Financial hardship	variable	For families for whom our bereavement or BMT grant is insufficient. Payable to family.

The maximum grant any one family may have over a twelve month period is £1,000 unless agreed by the Trustee Board for exceptional circumstances.

GRANTS OUTSIDE THE UK

For families living outside the UK we give grants as follows:

GRANT TYPE	AMOUNT	CONDITIONS
Bereavement	£300	Copy of death certificate stating ALD as cause of death or similar. Payable to family.
Bone Marrow Transplant	£300	Copy of letter stating patient requires BMT due to ALD. Payable to parents/guardians.
Equipment	variable	I nvoice/estimate for goods plus letter from medical professional stating necessity. Proof that they have approached local funders and been declined. Payable direct to provider.
Treatment	variable	I nvoice/estimate for treatment plus letter from medical professional stating necessity. Proof that they have approached local funders and been declined. Payable direct to provider.
Care	variable	I nvoice/estimate for care needs plus letter from medical professional stating necessity. Proof that they have approached local funders and been declined. Payable direct to provider.
Financial hardship	variable	For families for whom our bereavement or BMT grant is insufficient. Proof that they have approached local funders and been declined. Payable to family.

The maximum grant any one family may have over a twelve month period is £1,000 unless agreed by the Trustee Board for exceptional circumstances.
